Weather for last four days (1st June to 4th June, 2018)

Weather forecast for next five days (6th June to 10th June, 2018)

- Light to moderate rainfall is predicted on next five days.
- Sky will be partly to mainly cloudy in the next five days.
- Wind speed will be 3-11 km/hr. and the predominant wind direction will be Southeasterly to Southwesterly.
- Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35.0⁰C -36.0⁰C and minimum temperature is likely to be around 27.0⁰C-28.0⁰C.
- Maximum and minimum relative humidity will be in the range of 74% -82% and 31% -39%.

Crop	Stage	Disease pest	Advisory
Dry seeded paddy			--Start to collect seed of wet seeded rice from SSC, NSC etc. --Collect some variety like Sabita Foundation, Swarna sub-1 certified, IR-64, Hira T.L etc. --There is a great chance for getting monsoon rain within 3-4 days so farmers are suggested to prepare field wet seeded rice --Farmers who want to cultivate fish with paddy they are suggested to increase the height of bund at least ½ ft for storage of rain water
Poultry bird	Layer and grower	Low food intake due to hot and humid weather	--Keep less number of bird per cage --Arrange electric fan in the cage --Arrange more number of fresh water pot and avoid pond water for drinking purpose --Mix electrolyte with drinking water --Keep thickness of litter 1inch but never exceed 1 ^{1/2} inch --Apply lime if litter become wet due to rainy weather
Jackfruit	Fruits going to mature		--As tender fruit comes out from new branches cut the old branches for emergence of new branches after harvesting of mature fruit
Cattle	HP and black quarter and Worm infection due to hot and humid weather		--Immediate complete the vaccination before rain --Avoid grazing during mid-noon and afternoon hours --For better milk production keep the cowshed clean with slanting floor and arrange fan in the cowshed
