Sub: Admission to Master Degree Programmes for the session 2021-22

Applications are invited from Indian citizens only for admission to Master Degree Programmes (2-Years) of Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya (BCKV) at Mohanpur Campus for the academic session 2021-22. Interested candidates may apply for admission to the Master degree programmes through online mode. Link will be available on university website (www.bckv.edu.in).

(1) ALLOTMENT OF SEATS: As per Annexure-I

- (i) All Master Degree seats, excepting the ICAR seats, will be filled up amongst the candidates who are domicile to the state of West Bengal. Non-domicile candidates who did their graduation in BCKV will also be eligible for application.
- (ii) ICAR's nominees will be admitted as per prevailing rules.

(3) DEPARTMENTS / SUBJECTS OF MASTER DEGREE PROGRAMME:

(A) Faculty of Agriculture:

1) Agronomy, 2) Plant Pathology, 3) Entomology, 4) Agril. Economics, 5) Agril. Statistics, 6) Agril. 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(4) **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:**

(A) Agriculture and Horticulture (M.Sc.):

- (i) Candidates must have passed 4-year Bachelor Degree examination in Agriculture/ Horticulture. General and OBC candidates must secure Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of at least 6.50 in 10.00 scale whereas for SC/ST/PWD candidates, the said requirement is at least 5.50 in 10.00 scale. In traditional system where grade-points are not awarded, the General and OBC category candidates must have secured at least 60 % marks, whereas for SC/ST/PWD categories, the requirement is at least 50 % marks.
- (ii) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2) in General stream or Vocational stream securing at least 50 % marks in aggregate for General and OBC categories, whereas for candidates under SC/ST/PWD categories the said requirement is at least 40 % marks.
- (iii) Candidate who might have obtained his/her Bachelor Degree from a University where the concerned Faculty/College/Programme is not accredited by ICAR or is not aided by the State Government shall not be eligible for admission to Master Degree programme.
- (iv)Applicants having bachelor degree from other University or college will have to produce a certificate from appropriate authority mentioning that his/her Faculty/College is either ICAR-accredited or is aided by State Government before taking admission/ reporting, failing which his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.
- (v) All the candidates are required to submit photocopy of all transcripts at the time of Counseling/reporting for admission.

(B) Agricultural Engineering (M.Tech.):

- (i) Candidates must have passed 4-year Bachelor Degree examination in Agricultural Engineering. General and OBC candidates must secure Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of at least 6.50 in 10.00 scale, whereas for SC/ST/PWD candidates the said requirement is at least 5.50 in 10.00 scale. In traditional system where grade points are not awarded, the General and OBC category candidates must have secured at least 60 % marks, whereas for SC/ST/PWD categories the requirement is at least 50 % marks.
- (ii) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2) and securing at least 45 % in aggregate for general and OBC candidates and 40% for SC/ST/PWD candidates.
- (iii) Candidate who might have obtained his/her Bachelor Degree from any University where the concerned Faculty/College/Programme is not approved by AICTE or is not aided by the State Government shall not be eligible for admission to Master Degree programme.
- (iv) Applicants having Bachelor Degree from other University or college will have to produce a certificate from appropriate authority mentioning that his/her Faculty/ college/ Programme is either AICTE approved or is aided by State Government, before taking admission/ reporting failing which his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.
- (v) All the candidates are required to submit photocopy of all the transcripts at the time of Counseling/reporting for admission.
- (5) <u>IN-SERVICE CANDIDATE</u>: There shall be one additional seat reserved in each department for in-service candidate. In-Service candidates should have at least three years service experience in a Govt. Organization/Institute/University. Admission of the in-service candidates for Master Degree Programme will be made on the basis of merit list.
 - In-Service candidates must submit a "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from his/ her present employer at the time of reporting. After admission, the concerned students have to submit an approval letter of leave for a period of 2 years issued by his/her employer within two (2) months from the date of reporting, failing which his/her admission will be treated as cancelled without any further intimation.

- (6) <u>CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION</u>: If it is found at any stage that a candidate has obtained admission by misrepresentation and/or suppression of facts, his/her admission shall be liable to be cancelled.
- (7) <u>MODE OF APPLICATION (ONLINE) AND PAYMENT OF FEES (ONLINE ONLY)</u>: Apply online through the Viswavidyalaya website (<u>www.bckv.edu.in</u>). **Application fees is exempted for the year 2021-22.**

- (13) <u>SUBMISSION OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS</u> BY THE CANDIDATE AT THE TIME OF <u>REPORTING (AS UPLOADED AT THE TIME OF ONLINE APPLICATION)</u>: Candidates are hereby directed to produce photocopy of the following documents (as uploaded) along with ORIGINALS for verification at the time of Reporting/Admission:
- (i) Mark-sheets/Grade Cards of Examination: H.S. Examination (10+2 Standard), Bachelor Degree (4-Years Degree Course) [Both Side separately]
- (ii) Age-proof certificate [Birth Certificate/ Admit Card or Certificate of Secondary Examination (10th Standard)].
- (iii) SC/ST/PWD & OBC-A & OBC-B certificates from the competent authority.
- (iv) Domicile certificate issued by the competent authority (Chairman or Executive Officer of Municipality/Commissioner or Administrator of Municipal Corporation / Pradhan, Gram Panchayat /B.D.O./ S.D.O.).
- (v) AADHAAR card of the candidate.
- (vi) Two (2) copies of recent colour passport size photograph.
- (vii) Self-attested copy of valid medical certificate from appropriate authority (Sub-Divisional Medical Officer, Superintendent of State Hospital or above category) for person with disability (PWD) candidates.

- (14) <u>BLOOD ELECTROPHORESIS</u> (THALASSAEMIA) <u>TEST REPORT</u>: The candidates who are admitted after offline / online counseling are required to submit self attested copy of Blood Electrophoresis (Thalassaemia) test report to the Medical Officer, BCKV at the time of reporting.
- (15) <u>ANTI-RAGGING DECLARATION</u>: Anti-ragging declaration in the form of an affidavit (format to be downloaded from the University Website) would be required to be signed by the admitted candidates and their guardians and to be submitted to the Dean Students' Welfare on the date of reporting for classes/ date of reporting for hostel. Only after receipt of anti-ragging declaration, the University registration certificate will be issued to the admitted candidates.
- (16) Canvassing in any form will lead to disqualification of application.
- ❖ Special Attention: The merit list will be generated based on the marks provided by the applicants in the online application form. The merit list, counselling and/or reporting schedule, will be displayed on the University website. Admission will be made only on the basis of merit list following a process of counselling. On the day of reporting, the eligible candidates, after verification of documents with the data provided in the Application Form, will only be finally allowed to take admission.
